#### DRESS CODE

It is a student's responsibility to come to school dressed appropriately and ready to learn. Student apparel should be conducive to a positive learning environment. The following rules apply to all Nevada Union High School students at all times on campus and at all school activities:

- Nevada Union High School does not allow students to wear clothing or display paraphernalia that generates a hostile environment. Any apparel and/or paraphernalia containing words, symbols, and/or images violating another student's civil rights are not acceptable and will lead to disciplinary action.
- Apparel or accessories with depictions of weapons, discriminatory or sexually suggestive messages, tobacco, alcohol, drug-related images or brands, gang-affiliated messaging and/or wording are not allowed.
- For purposes of health and safety, and California state law, shoes must be worn at all times while on campus.
