Buy your ASB Card at the Student Store or online at the online Student Store to get as much savings as possible!





Important information you will need to apply for District Scholarships

We use *Going Merry* for our scholarship application process. You can visit the website here: <u>Going Merry</u>. Please note the following:

- Sign in with an appropriate personal email (do not use your school email).
- **Do not sign in with Google** on your school Chromebook, as the link will be attached to your school email. **Sign in with your email instead.**
- Create your profile and complete as much of it as possible.
- Begin working on your <u>four required writing responses</u>. These will need to be attached to each scholarship application.
- How to upload or request documents.

Additionally, you should start requesting two letters of recommendation:

- One from a staff member.
- One from a community member.

Important Dates:

- October 7: Our local scholarship program opens on Going Merry.
- **December 7**: Deadline for letters of recommendation to be uploaded to your Going Merry profile.
- January 10 at 9 PM: Deadline to submit your Going Merry scholarship applications.
