Course Description

Basic Credit Recovery is a course that allows students to make-up classes that they did not previously pass. Specific course descriptions provided depending on the course that the student needs. This course is an opportunity for students to earn credits towards graduation requirements. Credit recovery courses are designed to help students learn at their own pace and on their own time. The flexibility and design of these courses empower students to focus on exactly the content they need to in order to catch up to their peers, recover lost credits, and graduate on time. As the teacher I can adjust courses to match their scope and sequence, or customize courses for concept or unit recovery, so students can focus on just the parts of a course they still need to learn.

Note: Though you are encouraged to collaborate with peers when possible, all work turned in MUST be your OWN. No cheating or copying will be tolerated. All students involved will earn a "0" on that assignment and a phone call home.

Late Work Policy

All students are expected to submit homework on the due date. Late work will not be accepted after 10 school days. All IEPs accommodations for extra time will be implemented.

Grading Scale

Student Absences

Make-up work

- For any excused absences, you will receive full credit for any make-up work completed within the allowed time.
- If you know that you are going to be gone, you must get the assignments ahead of time. This will provide you with a better opportunity to keep on track while you are gone.
- Assignments that are due the day of the absence will be due the day you return.
- If you are planning on being gone for five or more days, an independent study contract must be obtained by you and brought to me at least two days before you leave. The assignments will be due the second day you come back. More time will not be given.
- This is an independent based course and if you do not complete it by the end of the semester then you may be eligible for an incomplete (I) on your report card. Together we will develop a plan for you to get caught up at the beginning of the next semester.
