FAFSA FOR COLLEGE BOUND SENIORS:


2024-2025 FAFSA / CADAA Workshop Brought to you by Sierra College Financial Aid: January 16, 2023 in the NU Cafeteria from 6-7pm

The California State Budget Act passed a law requiring all seniors' families to either fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the California Dream Act Application (CADAA), or an opt-out waiver.

Nevada Joint Union High School District is excited to announce some upcoming opportunities to learn more about this process and some workshops to help families fill out this year's FAFSA/CADAA.

We have two more opportunities to fill out the FAFSA/CADAA, with assistance from Sierra College, and NJUHSD counselors.

Workshop 1: January 16th- 6:00-7:00 hosted by Nevada Union
Workshop 2: January 18th - 6:00- 7:00 hosted by Bear River High School
These workshops are open to ALL NJUHSD students and families.

WHAT TO BRING:

- FSA ID
- GOVERNMENT ISSUED ID/DRIVER'S LICENSE
- SOCIAL SECURITY CARD
- OR PERMANENT RESIDENT CARD
- 2022 TAX DOCUMENTATION MAY BE NEEDED

BOTH PARENTS & STUDENTS SHOULD BRING THE DOCUMENTS LISTED ABOVE.

Create an FSA ID for your FAFSA

To submit an application for FAFSA, you must first create an FSA ID. The FSA ID is a username and password combination you use to log in to U.S. Department of Education (ED) online systems. The FSA ID is your legal signature and shouldn't be created or used by anyone other than you—not even your parent, your child, a school official, or a loan company representative. You'll use your FSA ID every year you fill out a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form and for the lifetime of your federal student loans.

Students AND parents need their own individual FSA IDS. Parents must create an account as well.



Personal Information

Enter your Name, Date of Birth, and Social Security Number.



Account Information

Create a username, enter your email address, and new password (Password must include: uppercase, lowercase, 1 number, and be at least 8 characters).



Permanent Address

Enter your Address, City, State, ZIP Code, and Mobile Phone Number.



Communication Preferences

Select the method of communication you'd like to utilize, Email or Postal Mail. Optional Communications include Email or Text Message. Select your Language Preference.



Challenge Questions

Select 4 challenge questions and input answers. These are used to retrieve your username/password if you are locked out of your account.



Confirm and Verify

Verify the information you provided for your account. Make any necessary edits, then agree to the Federal Student Aid's Terms and Conditions.



Enable Two-Step Verification

Enter your phone number and email address for verification. Set up the Authenticator App by downloading the app and scanning the OR code provided.
