

AP TEST DATES: AP Testing is coming up May 6 through May 17, 2024. Please click on the link to the right for the schedule.

**ELPAC TESTING:** It is that time of year again when all English Learner (EL) students take the ELPAC. The ELPAC is different from the CAASPP testing which students just finished up. California students in kindergarten through grade twelve classified as English Learners (EL) because English was not their first language take the ELPAC every year until they are Reclassified as proficient in English (RFEP). Students need to earn a 4 on the ELPAC to begin the process of Reclassifying as Fluent English Proficient

The ELPAC measures a student's proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing in the English language. Scores from the ELPAC tell a student's teachers about the areas in which they need extra support, or if they are ready to be Reclassified.

The Summative ELPAC assessment will take place on May 7 and May 8, at NU in room J-213, starting at 8:30AM. Students who participate in the ELPAC testing have been notified individually by Mrs. Toro, the EL Coordinator. We encourage students to try their very best on the ELPAC!

This is your friendly reminder that **ENROLLMENT IS OPEN!** 

Please visit <u>NUMiners.com</u> and the <u>"enroll" link</u> is located at the top! You will need to create a profile. If you have had a student previously attend NU, you will need to use the previous login and password. Our help desk number is 530.272.9998 or <u>Helpdesk@njuhsd.com</u> they are ready to help you locate your previous login if needed. In order to enroll you will need:

- Two DIFFERENT forms of address verification (ex: Driver License, PG&E bill, bank statement)
- Birth Certificate
- Immunization record (don't let this hold you up you can get a copy from your current school it's referred to as the "blue sheet".)

It is easiest to upload these documents when enrolling, but you are welcome to bring them into the office between the hours of 8:00-4:00 Mon-Fri, or you can email them to <a href="mailto:nuregistration2024@njuhsd.com">nuregistration2024@njuhsd.com</a>
