TEXTBOOKS AND LIBRARY BOOKS:

Start gathering up those textbooks and library books! Please return your library books, class novels and textbooks to the library before June 7th. *Any textbooks that don't get returned this school year will turn into*

<u>lost book fees over the summer</u>. Fees for lost or damaged books can be paid in the library with cash or check. If you would like to keep a library book over the summer, come to the library to renew.

<u>Seniors</u>, all of your library materials need to be returned and fines paid before June 6th, to receive your diploma on Graduation day. Otherwise, they are available in the front office on the following Monday.

Senior Chromebook & Charger returns will take place Tuesday, June 4th, and Wednesday, June 5th between 8:30 - 3:30. Students are responsible for removing stickers. Technology will be present to inspect devices. Technology staff will assess the condition of the Chromebooks and determine fees if necessary.

Two things to keep in mind to make sure your technology doesn't slow down your sprint to summer:


- 1. Use <u>Google Takeout</u> to save any content in your school account before it is disabled.
 - Cleaning supplies are available in the library
 - Charger cords must be wrapped up with velcro straps or rubber bands (available in the library)
 - If you are turning in a charger other than the one checked out to you with your chromebook, it must meet these requirements:
 - Has a USB-C plug
 - Has an output rating of 20 V and a minimum of 2.25 A or...
 - Has an output rating of 20 V and a minimum of 45 watts

If you are unable to achieve that minimum standard, you will be ineligible for the entire season. For those that are close to the standard, you may be asked to go on a practice-only contract at your Coach's discretion.

FRESHMAN ENROLLMENT FOR 2024/2025

Hello Nevada Union Parents and Freshman Class of 2028!

We can't wait to see all the new Freshman faces around campus, but we can't see any new faces unless you register your student!

This is your friendly reminder that **ENROLLMENT IS OPEN!**

Please visit NUMiners.com and the <a href="mailto:"enroll" link is located at the top! You will need to create a profile. If you have had a student previously attend NU, you will need to use the previous login and password. Our help desk number is 530.272.9998 or Helpdesk@njuhsd.com they are ready to help you locate your previous login if needed. In order to enroll you will need:

- Two DIFFERENT forms of address verification (ex: Driver License, PG&E bill, bank statement)
- Birth Certificate
- Immunization record (don't let this hold you up you can get a copy from your current school it's referred to as the "blue sheet".)

It is easiest to upload these documents when enrolling, but you are welcome to bring them into the office between the hours of 8:00-4:00 Mon-Fri, or you can email them to nuregistration2024@njuhsd.com
