Any Spring student-athlete that has not earned the minimum 2.0 GPA for the quarter or has more than one F, will be asked to leave their respective teams to focus on their academics. Our help desk number is 530.272.9998 or <u>Helpdesk@njuhsd.com</u> they are ready to help you locate your previous login if needed. In order to enroll you will need:

- Two DIFFERENT forms of address verification
 - (ex: Driver License, PG&E bill, bank statement)
- Birth Certificate
- Immunization record

It is easiest to upload these documents when enrolling, but you are welcome to bring them into the office between the hours of 8:00-4:00 Mon-Fri, or you can email them to <u>nuregistration2024@njuhsd.com</u>
