

4 year universities and the A-G

The University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) require entering freshmen to complete certain courses in high school. Complete a minimum of 15 college-preparatory courses (<u>a-g courses</u>), with at least 11 finished prior to the beginning of your senior year.

a. History/Social Science (2 years)

b. English (4 years)

- c. Mathematics (3 years, UC recommends 4)
- d. Laboratory Science (2 years, UC recommends 3)
- e. Language Other than English (2 years, UC recommends 3)

f. Visual/Performing Arts (1 year)

g. College Preparatory Elective (1 year)
