Contacting Staff

Staff members can be contacted via email by selecting the staff directory on numiners.com under Staff Directory. Teachers list their contact information on their syllabus for each class. We are unable to transfer phone calls to classrooms during the school day.

ParentVUE

To check your student's schedule, grades, assignments, and recent attendance, you'll need to use ParentVUE. You will receive an email with login instructions before the end of August. If you forget your username/password or miss the login time period, you can call the Help Desk Monday - Friday for assistance at (530) 272-9998.

Attendance

Please notify the Attendance office by phone or in writing within 24 hours if your student has been or will be absent from school. Written notes need to include: student name, ID number, date of absence or date and time of departure and reason. Note must include signature of parent or legal guardian and the date the note was written. Whenever possible please return with Doctor's note. In case of early dismissal, student must bring note to attendance office prior to leaving campus and in turn they are issued a pass off campus. School passes may be picked up before school, between classes or during lunch. Any student leaving campus without going through proper checkout process will receive two hours of detention. NU is a closed campus. Students are not allowed to leave without proper checkout. Parking lots are off limits during the school day.

Counselors

Meals

NU Food service strives to bring quality food to our high school meal programs. Food is cooked in the kitchen and the menu hosts a wide variety to keep students excited about their nutrition.

- Breakfast is served from 8:00am 8:30am in the cafeteria only for \$2.00. Any student on the lunch program is eligible to receive a free breakfast.
- Lunches are \$4.00. We accept cash, or you can send cash or check with your student to be put on their account at any serving line, or you can prepay for lunches at numiners.com through MySchoolBucks program. Lunches are served in the cafeteria, serveries at the end of E-Wing/Library and in the Quad outside of the cafeteria. The E-Wing/Library servery only serves ala cart items.
- The menu is posted on the website and is displayed on the electronic menu boards in the cafeteria.
- Items available every day include pizza, sandwiches, large salads, quesadillas and a salad bar. Two different specials are served daily in the cafeteria and pizza servery.
- We sell drinks, fruit slushies, cookies, frozen yogurt, ala cart and snack items too.
- Free and Reduced-Price Meals Information/applications were mailed home and are available at numiners.com. All of the above services are available to all students on this program.
- Families do need to submit a new application annually; one application per household in the NUHS School District. All applications must be completed within the first two weeks of school to certify your children for free or reduced-price meals. Contact Iva Lee at (530) 273-3351 ext. 202 if you have questions.

Lockers:

- Lockers are reserved for **free**. Students must have a student ID and school email address. **Students receive an email to their school email account to start the process.**
