- Show respect for the officials. No remarks will be tolerated.
- Maintain self-control at all times. Spectators are to remain on their own side and are not to be in the opponent's cheering area, not to stand on the court sidelines, and not to throw objects of any size or type. They are not to taunt the opponents.

Fans violating these rules will be asked to leave. Failure to heed warnings from staff supervision may result in further disciplinary action, including suspension or banning from subsequent events.

REGISTER FOR THE PSAT BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2022: Test Date: October 12, 2022

The PSAT/NMSQT is the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test. The PSAT is a great primer for the SAT, and even the ACT, but it's more than just a trial run. PSAT scores are used to identify National Merit Scholars and award merit scholarships. More than 3.4 million high school students (mostly juniors and sophomores) take this nationwide, multiple-choice test every year.

What is the PSAT and why is it important?

The PSAT won't count towards your college admissions applications, but it is the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship. Some of the highest scoring students may win scholarship money, so while you shouldn't stress out about the PSAT, you certainly shouldn't ignore it either. Use the PSAT as practice for the SAT and ACT and an important guidepost on your college admissions journey.

What is on the PSAT test?

The PSAT has two sections: Math and Evidence-Based Reading and Writing. You'll encounter passage-based questions—sometimes accompanied by tables, graphs, and charts—and math problems drawing upon algebra, geometry, and a little trig.

STUDENT ID CARDS: Students must have their Student ID to do the following:

- **Check in for lunch (or provide your student ID number in the keypad)**
- **Ride the Bus: Drivers will not allow anyone to ride the bus without an ID card**
 - ID cards need to be presented to ride to and from school.
 - For safety reasons we don't want to assume everyone at a Bus Stop should be able to ride the bus.
- Purchase Dance Tickets
- Check in to events: Games, Rallies, Performance Arts shows, etc.

OPEN PERIOD STICKERS: Juniors and Seniors that have an open period, please report to Tammy Shurte, Assistant Principal's Secretary to receive your Open Period Sticker for your ID card. The sticker let's staff know you are able to leave campus. As a reminder, any student with an open period is not accounted for (attendance not taken) during that period and must leave campus per the contract. Students will need to see their counselor to pick up an Open Period Contract that parents will sign. Students will return the form to Tammy Shurte, Assistant Principal's Secretary, to receive an off-campus sticker for their ID card.
