FAFSA / CADAA Workshop: The counseling department has put together a FAFSA/CADAA Workshop, Thursday, **December 15th from 6:30PM-8PM.**

If students and parents bring the information listed below, they will be able to get their application completed during this workshop. [Attached is the flyer.](#)

What students need for the workshop:

- A device that you can use to access the internet (an NJUHSD student Chromebook is fine)
- Student's Social Security number
- Parent's Social Security numbers if you are a dependent student
- Student's driver's license number if you have one
- Student Alien Registration number if you are not a U.S. citizen
- Federal tax information, tax documents, or tax returns, including IRS W-2 information, for student and for your parents if you are a dependent student:
 - IRS Form1040
 - Foreign tax return or IRS Form 1040-NR
 - Tax return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, or Palau
- Records of your untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans noneducation benefits, for students and parents if you are a dependent student

- Information on cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate (but not including the home in which you live); and business and farm assets for you and for your parents if you are a dependent student
