NEXT YEAR'S COURSE SELECTION

Since the start of the school year, the Counseling Department has been meeting with all students to connect and provide information to help assist students with their future planning for both high school and beyond.

Students met with counselors in a group information setting to review graduation requirements and general, grade specific pieces of information that can assist in planning for their future. Following these informational sessions, students met with counselors individually to review their transcripts and develop an Individual Academic Plan (IAP) based on your students interests and goals for their future. This plan was shared with your student through their Google Drive and will continue to be updated with your student and their counselor each year.

Right now, students have access to choose their classes for the 2022-23 school year. Through January 21st, they will log in to StudentVUE account to do this. They have been given the information they need for this process including directions, as well as:

You can log in to your ParentVUE account to see the classes your student has selected for next year but you must be logged into StudentVUE to add or change requests.
