There will be summer school this year. The hope is to have teachers teaching curriculum rather than apex. Students will still have the option to take apex. The management team will be working on planning what summer school will look like.

Melissa, I know you are all doing so much so it is difficult to add more. It would be great if counselors could do more 1-1 phone calls reaching out to students, but understands that they are extremely busy and putting out fires daily.

Kelly mentioned the need for another school counselor in order to meet all students' needs. Counselors each have about 360 students. If that number was dropped counselors would have the opportunity to meet with their students more frequently, provide intervention, or refer them to the many programs we have on campus to meet the students needs.
