4. REPORTS
 - A. Students: Senior ball this weekend. Staff V. Senior basketball was a success. Students won. Band had Spring Swing which was also a success. The board meeting had student representatives from Nevada Union sharing concerns with racism policy. Senior trip coming up- to Disneyland.
 - B. Principal report (non-action): CAASP testing- 97% participation met. AP testing is completed except for make ups. Kelly met with Vals and Sals- 36 valedictorian and 2 salutatorians. After next year we will only have one valedictorian and one salutatorian. Honors night will continue. Staff meeting tomorrow for training on culture on campus. Josie Andrews has been the connection to CTA trainers but the trainers have not been able to connect in our calendar but we were able to secure a local community liaison with GV Police Department. Students have brought a policy proposal to include a Nevada Union Site Policy relating to equity and inclusion. Trainings will continue at the district level. Senior projects, finals and graduation are all continuing as normal.
 - C. WASC (Western Association of Schools and Colleges - non-action item) Visit scheduled for next year. We will get back into community groups to prepare for the visit. We will showcase positives but also identify areas for improvement.

A. Approval of the Title 1 Budget - Tim Reid- Overview of Title I: support for students at risk of failing in school. Main identifying metric is enrollment in the free and reduced lunch program. Enrollment reduces at the high school level from the elementary based on families not signing up. Site Title I metric is enrollment in less than grade level Math and English. Behavior has also been added in the past few years and Title I staff have assisted with interventions related to behaviors. Three case managers and a supervisor are funded through Title I. Next year there will be English companion class offered to sophomores that show a need for support in reading and can work to make up credit for freshman English. Moved by Anika and Katie seconded to approve the title one budget for the 2022/2023 school year. Passed voice vote

B. Safety

1. Safety Drills Monday, May 16, 2022- Fairly successful drill. There had been a fire alarm on Thursday which impacted how the alarms were heard during the drill. Stayed under 20 minutes for both drills.
2. Catapult Update- Mrs. Rhoden was able to practice using Catapult for the drills. Went very well. Staff and students will be trained to use it next year.
